

The Maples Homeowners Association Pool Rules

THERE IS NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY. This is a private pool for the exclusive use of residents, their immediate family and their guests. Residents, family and guests use these facilities and swim at their own risk. The Association and its agents are not responsible and will be held harmless for accidents or injuries to any member, member(s) children, and/or their guest(s). The Association is not responsible for personal property at the pool. Please respect the rights of your neighbors while enjoying our community's pool.

The Amenities Center & Pool may be used by members in good standing subject to the following rules:

- This area is for members, their immediate family, and their non-resident guests only. Maximum of four (4) non-resident guests per household. All guests must be accompanied by an adult household member(s) who is responsible for any damages and actions of their guests.
- Children under the age of 16 are NOT permitted at the pool unless under the direct supervision of their parents, guardian or an accompanying adult.
- The swimming pool is available during the pool season from 6:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m. for adults only 21 and older and from 9:00 am until 9:00 p.m. for all ages.
- Adult members have the responsibility to enforce rules to ensure the safety of all patrons.
- Any damage or cost incurred by the Association from damages or negligence will be billed to the members account and collectible as an assessment, and the member will be suspended from the pool permanently.
- Access is ONLY through the gates using your access card. All residents must have their access card to gain admittance to or use the pool. If you do not have your card, you will be asked to leave the pool area and return with your card. Keep gate closed at all times. Access cards may only be used by the person that it was issued to.
- Association personnel may make regular pool checks and perform upkeep and maintenance work.
- No glass containers are permitted inside pool fence. All litter must be deposited in trash containers.
- Smoking is not permitted around the pool or on the terrace.
- Running, pushing and horseplay are prohibited on the pool deck. Diving into the pool is not allowed. Behavior must not endanger the welfare or enjoyment of the pool by others.
- Pets are not permitted in the pool area by order of the Health Department.
- No Balloons are allowed.
- The use of earphones is encouraged for those who bring music to the pool.
- Flotation devices/toys are permitted as long as it does not interfere with other swimmers. All pool toys/balls must be designed for pool use; no real footballs, baseballs, basketballs, or any other professional type balls allowed.
- Towels may not be used to reserve chairs.
- No private pool parties.
- Infants in diapers must use swim diapers in the pool.
- Because of the large number of residents at The Maples, these rules will be strictly enforced. Residents of The Maples access, use and enjoyment of the facilities must come first.
